
Damage record



Had an accident and called emergency services (000) if necessary? As a priority, record all the other driver's details first. (Our comprehensive Accident Information Data Sheet makes it easy.) If your car is clearly undrivable, or if you suspect the drive-train may be damaged, do not attempt to drive the vehicle home. Contact TAMMS. In most states we can arrange towing from the accident scene or from a nominated location.
